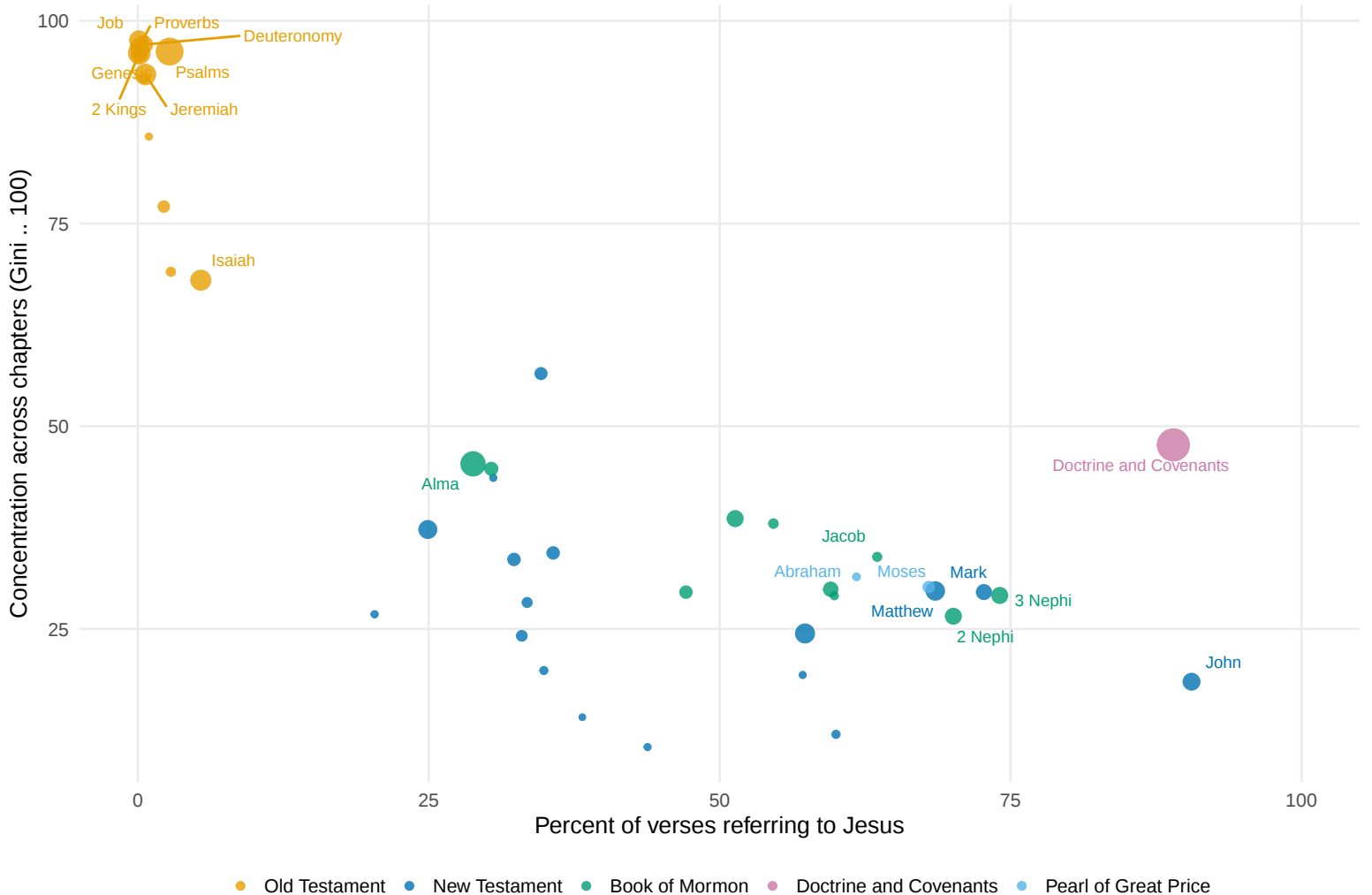


Density and concentration are different things

Each point is a book. Horizontal: what share of its verses refer to Jesus. Vertical: how unevenly those references are spread across its chapters (Gini over chapter-level counts). Point size is book length.



Vertical axis is a Gini coefficient over chapter-level counts, not a rate. Books with at least 5 qualifying chapters and one reference. Old and New Testament books are shared with the Protestant (also Community of Christ), Doctrine and Covenants and Pearl of Great Price are Latter-day Saint.
