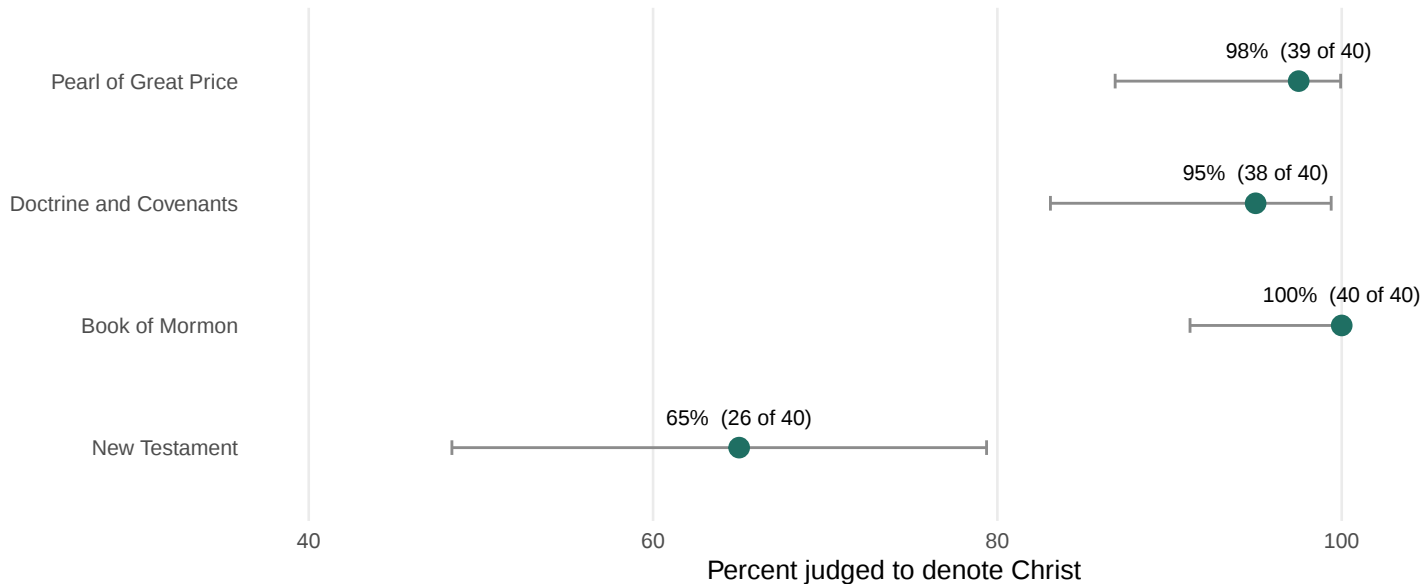


When a verse says only "the Lord", is it Jesus?

Forty verses per volume drawn at random from those coded on the generic title alone, read in context and judged one by one. Exact binomial intervals. The New Testament is the only volume where the text itself usually settles it -- Paul contrasts 'God our Father' with 'the Lord Jesus Christ'.



In Restoration scripture the identification of the Lord with Jehovah, and of Jehovah with the premortal Christ, is doctrinal rather than textual: the verses themselves rarely distinguish Father from Son. Coded by one coder.
