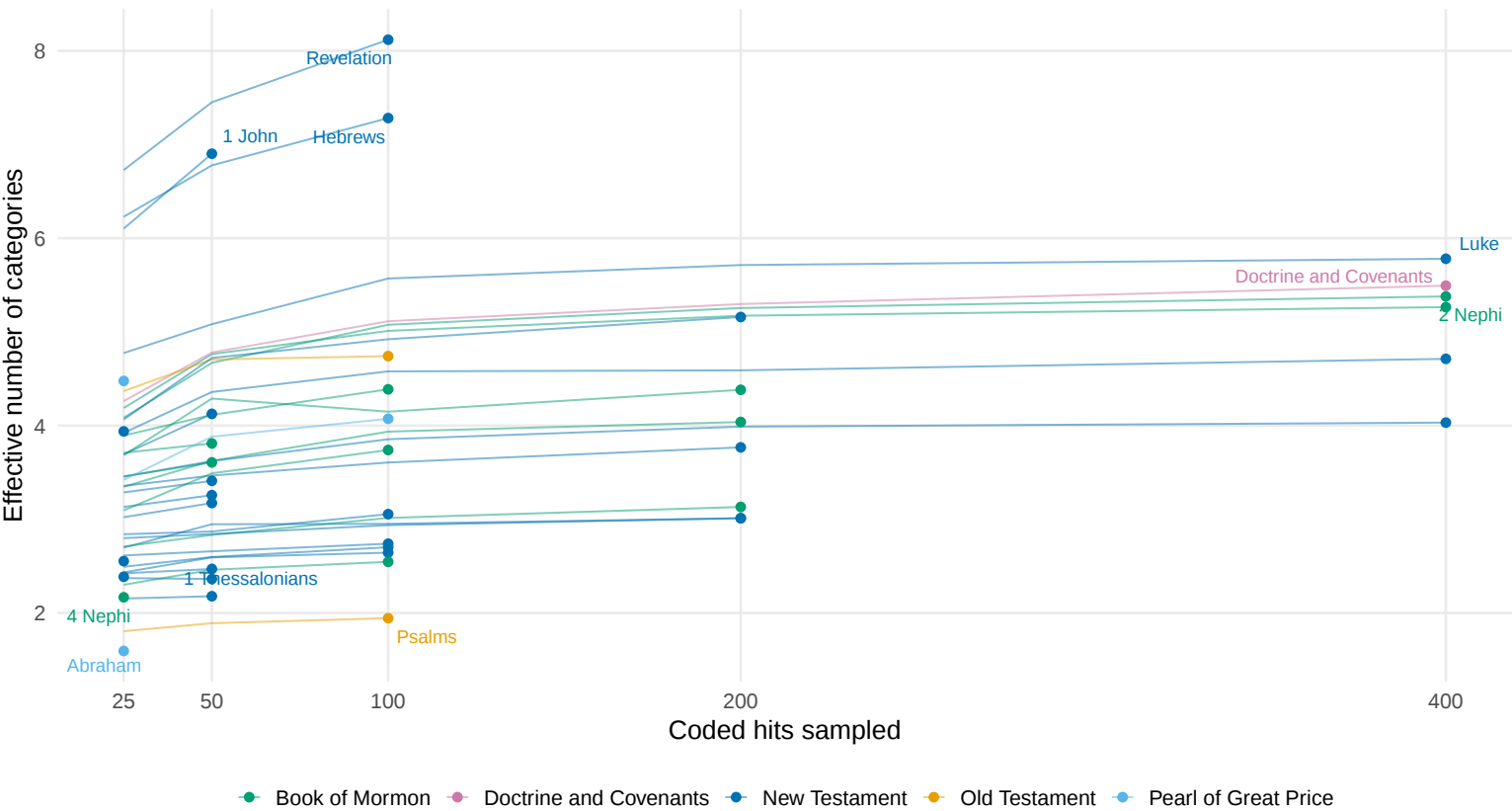


# How many different ways does a book name Jesus?

Effective number of vocabulary categories (exponentiated Shannon entropy), rarefied to a common number of coded hits so that long books are not credited with variety they owe to length.  
A line that stays low is a book that says the same thing repeatedly.



Books with at least 25 coded hits. Table, with canon membership: output/analysis/D2\_tab\_diversity.csv.  
Old and New Testament books are shared with the Protestant, Catholic and Orthodox canons; the Book of Mormon (also Community of Christ), Doctrine and Covenants and Pearl of Great Price are Latter-day Saint.
