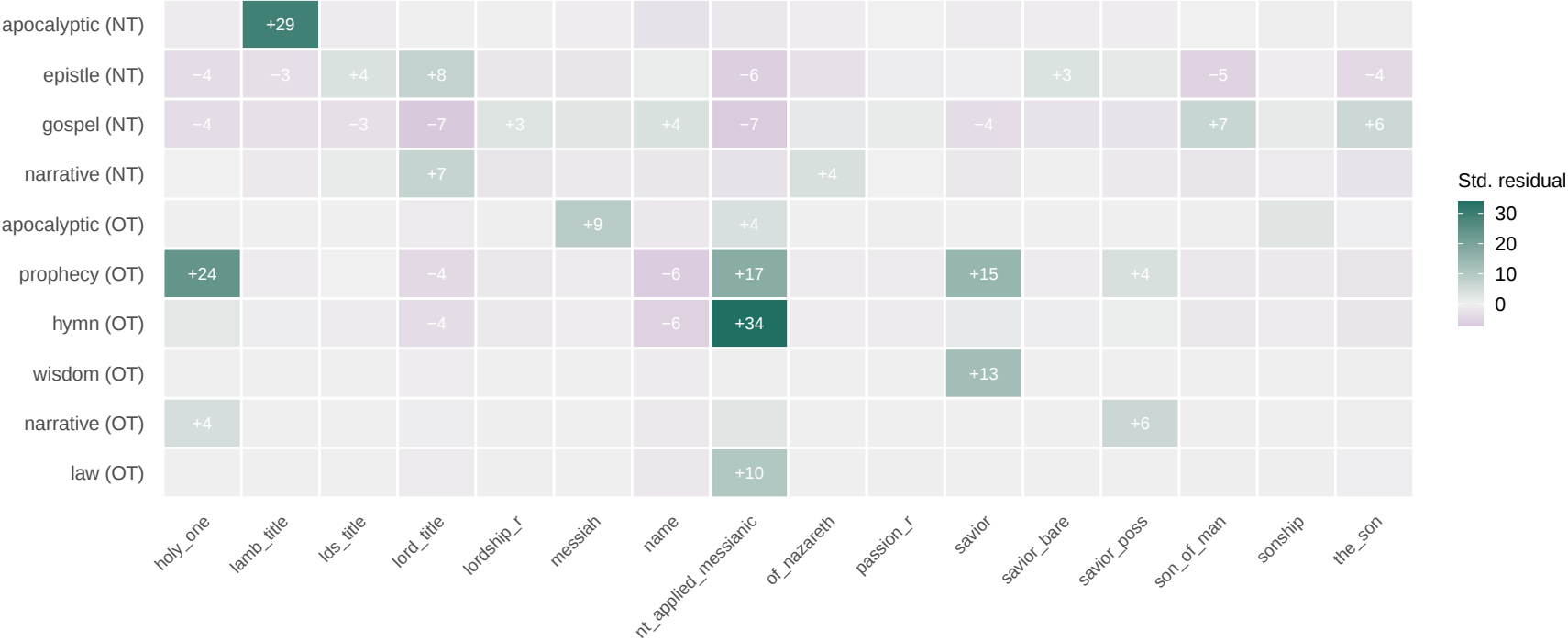


Which titles belong to which kind of writing

Standardised residuals from independence: green where a genre uses a vocabulary more than its overall share of references would predict, purple where less. King James Bible only, with genre assigned at book level and labelled by testament -- Daniel and Revelation are both apocalyptic and sit on opposite sides of the canon.



Book-level genre is a deliberate simplification: mixed books (Daniel, Zechariah) are assigned their dominant form. Chapter-level coding would be better and is listed as future work.
