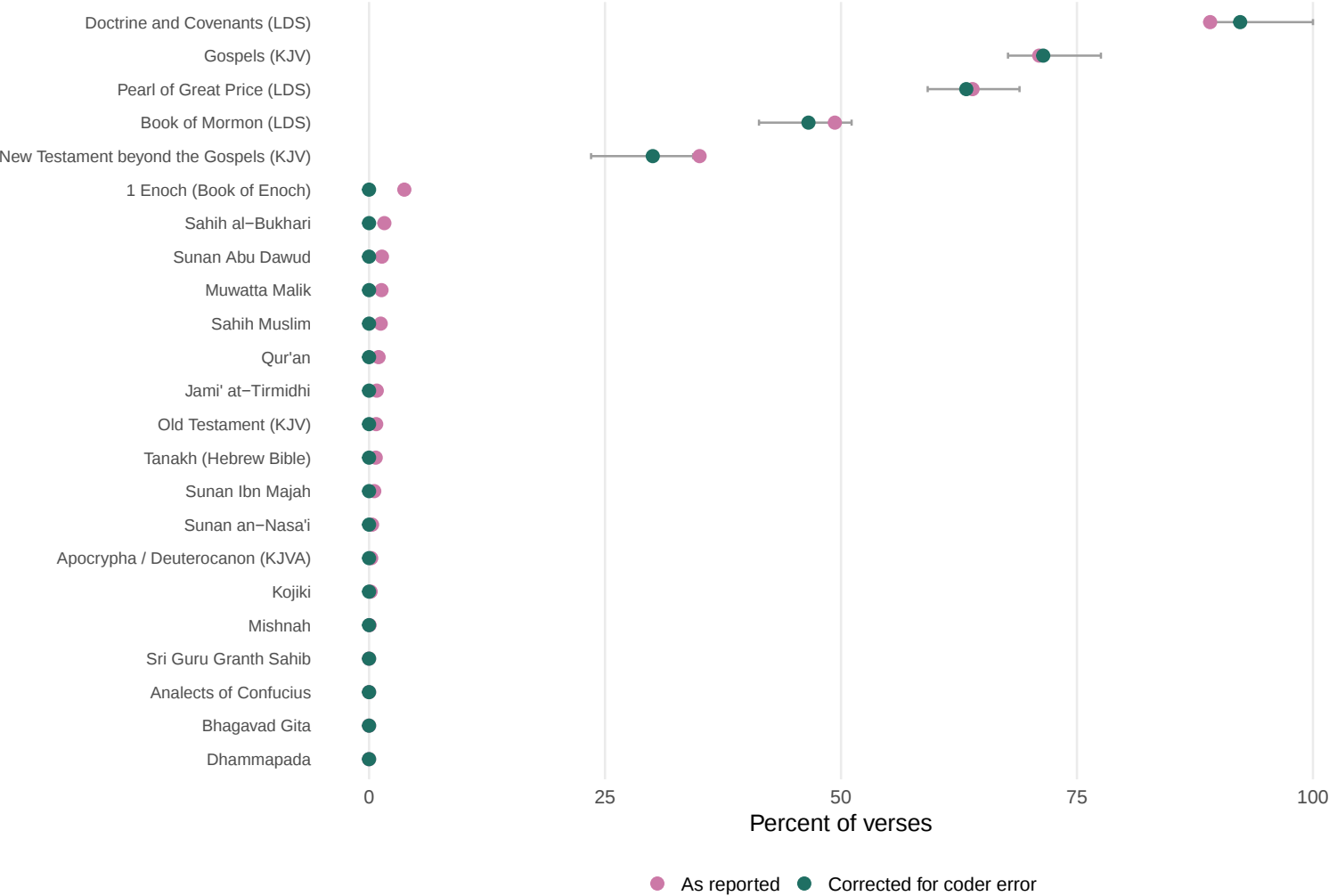


A pooled coder-error stress test on every rate

Rogan-Gladen correction using a single pooled sensitivity and specificity from the 143-verse validation sample, with a Beta posterior on each. H1 shows the explicit and contextual tiers have very different error profiles, so one pooled correction is a stress test rather than a better estimate.



Works of at least 300 text units. Low-rate corpora clamp to zero wherever the observed rate falls below the pooled false-positive rate -- an artefact of the correction, not evidence that they contain no references. Table: output/analysis/H2_tab_corrected_rates.csv
