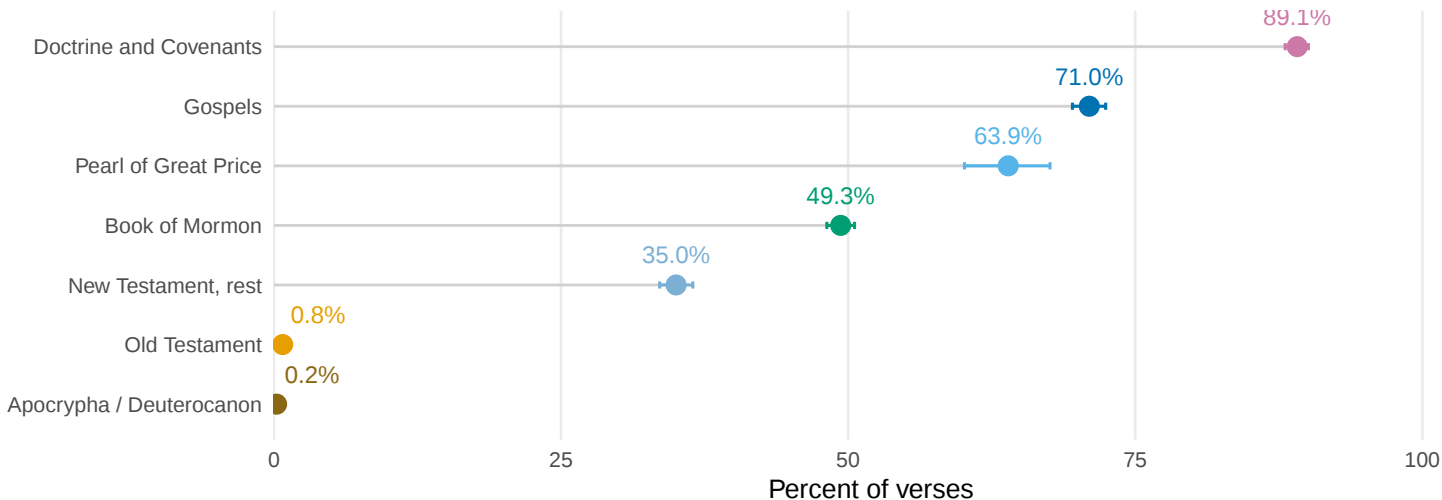


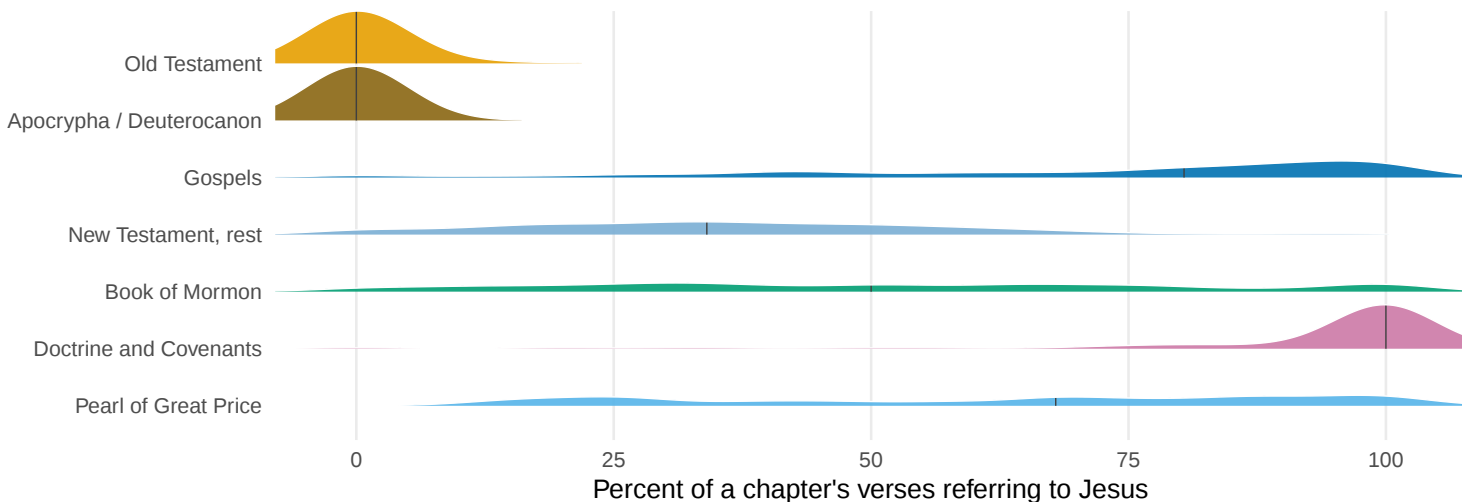
The Book of Mormon against four biblical baselines

Percent of verses referring to Jesus Christ: the five Latter-day Saint volumes, with the New Testament split into the Gospels and everything after them, and the Apocrypha/deuterocanon from the King James with Apocrypha added — scripture for Catholic, Orthodox and Ethiopian Orthodox readers, and neither Old Testament nor New. Chapters under 5 verses omitted below.

Verse-level rate, with 95% Wilson intervals



Distribution across chapters; the vertical line is the median chapter



Book of Mormon 49.3% vs. the whole Bible 13.9%; difference 35.5 points, $p < 1e-16$. Against the New Testament alone (52.1%) the gap is -2.8 points, $p = 0.00098$.
