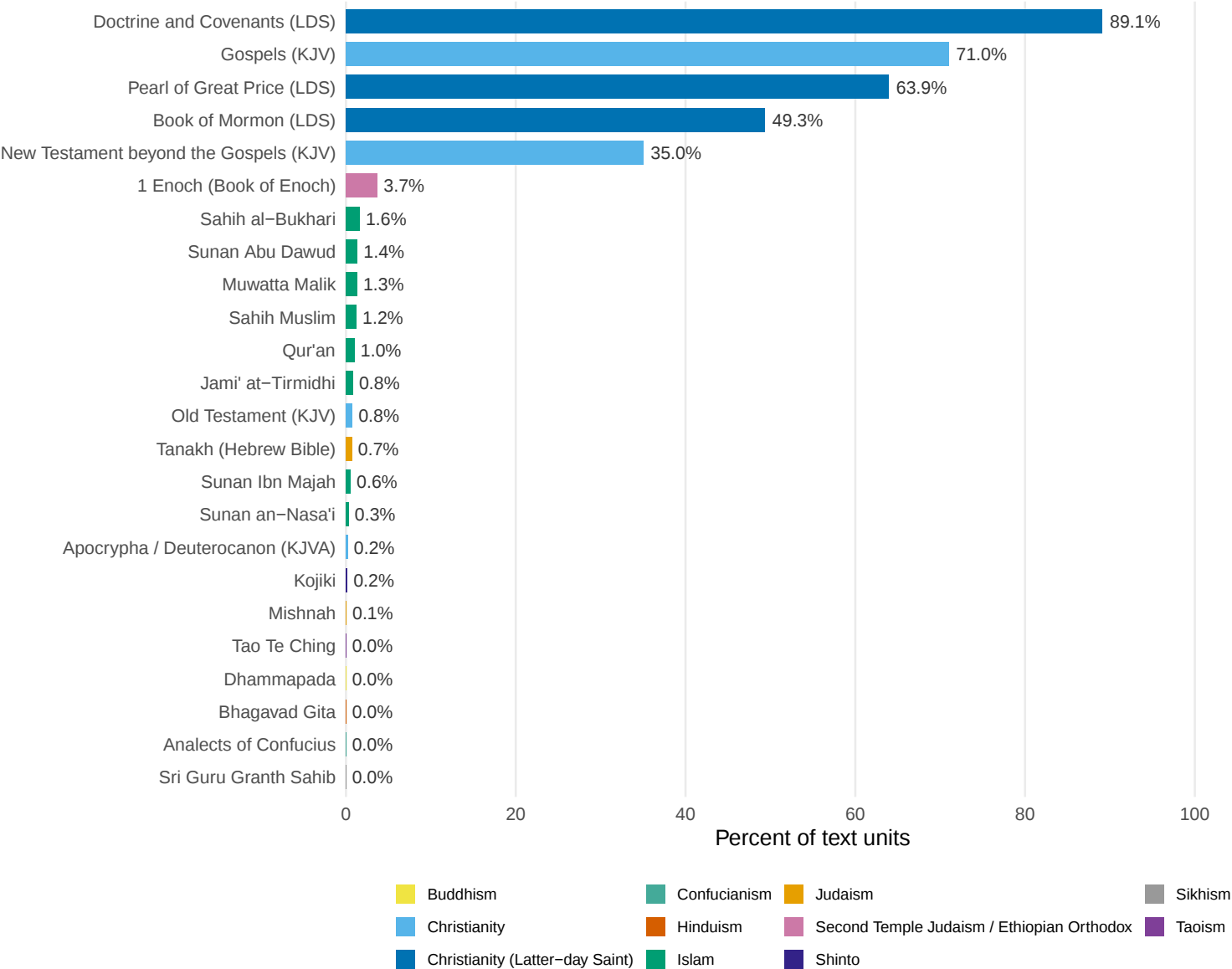


Share of text units referring to Jesus Christ, by work

Percent of each work's text units — biblical verses, Qur'anic ayat, hadith reports, and each source's own verse-like divisions elsewhere. One coding rule throughout: a name or title of Jesus, or a unit in which he speaks or is the referent of a pronoun.



Canons with at least 150 verses. The Bible is split into its testaments and shown as the King James Version; across 24 full Protestant editions the Old Testament ranges 0.7–1.0% and the New 38.7–55.8%. Coding rule and validation: docs/CODEBOOK.md, README section 9.
