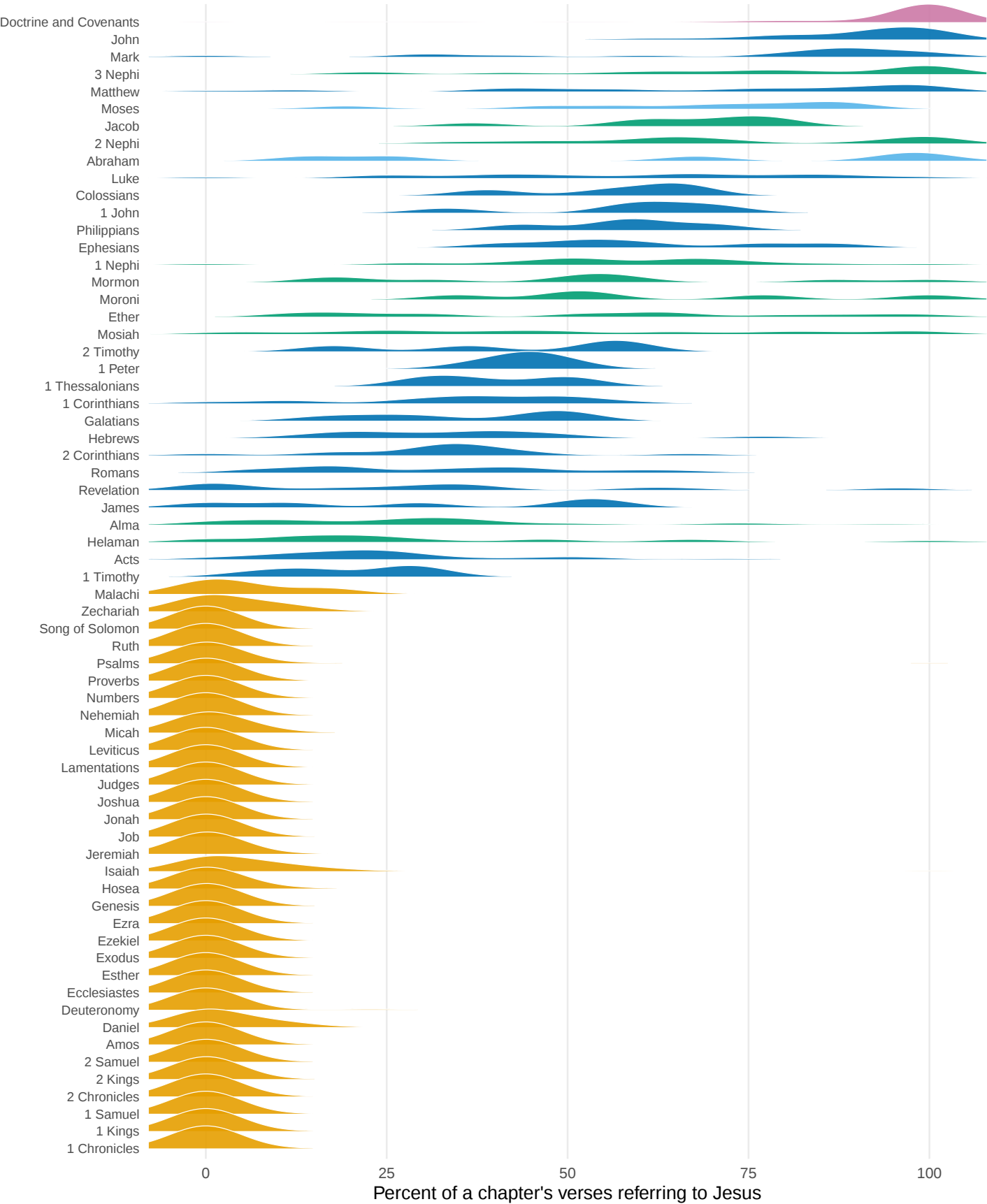


How evenly is Christ distributed within each book?

Each ridge is the distribution across a book's chapters of the percent of verses referring to Jesus. Books ordered by median chapter. Chapters with fewer than 5 verses omitted; books with fewer than 4 such chapters omitted, which drops the single-chapter books (Joseph Smith--Matthew, Joseph Smith--History, the Articles of Faith) and the shortest epistles.

A wide ridge means the book concentrates its Christ material in particular chapters; a narrow one means it is spread evenly. Old and New Testament books are shared with the Protestant, Catholic and Orthodox canons; the Book of Mormon (also Community of Christ), Doctrine and Covenants and Pearl of Great Price are Latter-day Saint.
